Turn Around Principle 2

Ensure Teachers are Effective and Able to Improve Instruction

Student will do monthly rigorous constructed responses across all curricula with results assessed by rubric that measures transferable skills with scores reported to Homeroom quarterly to demonstrate growth with all students meeting standard

- Score reported quarterly
- Rubric based on curriculum
- Student tracking own progress
- Growth in Claims scores

Turn Around Principle 4

Strengthen the Schools Instructional Program

All Staff will teach the curriculum with fidelity using workshop model to improve first instruction and student engagement as demonstrated by learning walks with an increase over the year of 80%.

Turn Around Principle 6

Establish a School Environment that Improves Safety and Discipline

Classroom participation in PBIS through mindfulness training, self regulation and restorative discipline practice while improving efficiency and use of tier teams to increase student time in the classroom and engagement.

- Daily Mindfulness advisory
- Book Study on Restorative Discipline
- Stronger Tier 1, 2 and 3 teams with clear roles
- Readiness to Learn Coach

Other Turn Around Principles addressed in the HMS Plan

- **P1– Strong Leadership**– Break Through Coaching to get into the classrooms.
- **P3– Extended time for student learning**– PAWS intervention period Tuesday –Friday
- **P5-Use data for Improvement**– Monthly collaboration for all staff focusing on achievement data. Intervention data for Tier Teams.
- **P7– Family and Community Engagement**– Math nights every 6 weeks for all parents. Stronger use of PTSA to bring in communication
